We offer various courses to help members further their family life, spiritual growth, and ministry preparation. Some examples of courses offered are Crown Financial Classes, MasterLife, Precept Bible Study, Discipline by design, etc. An updated schedule will be posted at least one month in advance of the start of the semester.

Crown Financial Classes

The Crown Small Group Study is a 10 week in-depth study of what scripture teaches about money and possessions. Graduates have confirmed that marriages are being strengthened and individuals are finding their way out of debt. They are also becoming consistent savers, generous givers, and prudent consumers. Most importantly, people are entering into a closer relationship with Jesus Christ as they learn to apply His Word. Groups meet for 2 hours every week and include scripture memorization and interactive discussions.

A required orientation class will be held on August 27. Only those who have attended the class may join the study. These classes are held every semester. The next orientation class will be sometime in January 2007. Watch for details.
