- VI. **S**eek To **Discipline** Their Children Consistently
- A. Discipline Should Begin **Early** in Life  
(Proverbs 13:24)
  - B. Discipline Should be **Tailor-Made**  
for the Child (Proverbs 23:13-14; 29:17)
  - C. Discipline Should be Grounded in **Love**  
(Proverbs 3:11-12)
- VII. **S**pend **Time** With Their Children
