I. I Am A **Manager**, Not An **Owner** (Job 41:11)

Job 41:11 “Who has given to Me that I should repay him? Whatever is under the whole heaven is Mine.”

Haggai 2:8 “‘The silver is Mine and the gold is Mine,’ declares the LORD of hosts.”

Deuteronomy 8:18a “You shall remember the LORD your God, for it is He who is giving you power to make wealth,”

II. I Should Avoid **Unwise** Investments (Matthew 6:19)

Matthew 6:19 “Do not lay up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal.”

III. I Should Seek **Safe** and **Profitable** Investments (Matthew 6:20)

Matthew 6:20 “But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in or steal;”

IV. My **Heart** Follows My **Investments** (Matthew 6:21)

Matthew 6:21 “for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.”
