## FINAL JUDGMENT

REVELATION 20:7-15

**Introduction:** Today we have come to the most terrifying passage in all of the Revelation—and perhaps the entire Bible—as we see the ultimate destiny of those who die apart from faith in Jesus Christ.

**I. The Final Rebellion** (Revelation 20:7-10)

**A. The Instigator of the Rebellion** (20:7)

Revelation 20:7 “When the thousand years are completed, Satan will be released from his prison.”


**B. Participants in the Rebellion** (20:8)

Revelation 20:8 “Satan will come out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together for the war; the number of them is like the sand of the seashore.”

**1. Judgment of Sinners** (20:9)

Revelation 20:9 “And they came up on the broad plain of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city, and fire came down from heaven and devoured them.”

### **2. Judgment of Satan (20:10)**

Revelation 20:10 “And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.”

#### **II. The Great White Throne Judgment (Revelation 20:11-15)**

##### **A. The Description of the Judgment (20:11)**

Revelation 20:11 “Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them.”

##### **B. The Subjects of the Great White Throne Judgment (20:12a, 13)**

Revelation 20:12a, 13 <sup>12a</sup> “And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, <sup>13</sup> and the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one of them according to their deeds.”

##### **C. The Basis for the Judgment (20:12b, 14)**

Revelation 20:12b, 14 <sup>12b</sup> “Books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds. <sup>14</sup> Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire.”

##### **D. The Result of the Judgment (20:15)**

Revelation 20:15 “And if anyone’s name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.”
