Introduction: Although the occupant of the White House is changing January 20, there are four truths about God that will never change.

I. **God’s Sovereignty Has Not Changed.** (Psalm 103:19)

Psalm 103:19 “The Lord has established His throne in the heavens, and His sovereignty rules over all.”

Psalm 115:3 “But our God is in the heavens; He does whatever He pleases.”

Job 42:2 “I know that you can do anything and that no one can stop you.” (TLB)

Daniel 4:35 “All the inhabitants of the earth are accounted as nothing, but He does according to His will in the host of heaven and among the inhabitants of earth; and no one can ward off His hand or says to Him, ‘What have You done?’”

Ephesians 1:11 “We have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to His purpose who works all things after the counsel of His will.”

Romans 13:1-2 ¹ “Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God. ² Therefore whoever resists authority has opposed the ordinance of God; and they who have opposed will receive condemnation upon themselves.”

Acts 2:23 “This Man [Jesus], delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put Him to death.”
