A FISH TALE LUKE 5:1-11

- I. The Story (Luke 5:1-11)
 - A. Jesus' Public Teaching (Luke 5:1-3)

Luke 5:1-3 “¹Now it came about that while the multitude were pressing around Him and listening to the word of God, He was standing by the lake of Gennesaret; ²and He saw two boats lying at the edge of the lake; but the fishermen had gotten out of them, and were washing their nets. ³And He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to put out a little way from the land. And He sat down and began teaching the multitudes from the boat.”

- B. Jesus' Personal Challenge (Luke 5:4-11)

Luke 5:4-5 “⁴And when He had finished speaking, He said to Simon, ‘Put out into the deep water and let down your nets for a catch.’ ⁵And Simon answered and said, ‘Master, we worked hard all night and caught nothing, but at Your bidding I will let down the nets.’”

Luke 5:6-7 “⁶And when they had done this, they enclosed a great quantity of fish, and their nets began to break; ⁷and they signaled to their partners in the other boat, for them to come and help them. And they came, and filled both of the boats, so that they began to sink.”
